

8N Ford Tractor Lift

If you look closely at the wheels on Larry Morrison's 1948 Ford 8N, you will see that all four wheels are off the ground. The pipe structure under the tractor is designed to, with the aid of the tractor's hydraulics, provide the lift. For those who have not seen such a demonstration, it seems a little magical when they notice that all four wheels are free to turn. Some uses of the lift are to drain fluids, do maintenance such as brake work, switch the tires/wheels around, and widen the tractor wheels/tires for cultivating . And too, it is handy for installing tire chains . Safety measures should be taken when crawling under the tractor while it is up. It might be better to just refrain from getting anywhere near being under the tractor with it jacked up.
